This interactive workshop will guide participants through the principles of coordinated services teams; building trust with families and youth; development of the interagency team; care coordination responsibilities; and team facilitation skills including conflict management. Through hands-on activities, participants will learn how to guide a multi-agency family-centered team through the process of completing a strength-based assessment, interagency plan of care, plan for crisis, and transition out of the formal team process.
