This two-day workshop is intended for care coordinators and potential team members who wish to learn the fundamentals of the wraparound process used in CST with an emphasis on care coordination and team facilitation responsibilities and skills.

This interactive workshop will guide participants through the principles of wraparound; building trust with families and youth; development of the interagency team; care coordination responsibilities; and team facilitation skills including conflict management. Through hands-on activities, participants will learn how to guide multi-agency family and youth-centered teams through the process of completing a strength-based assessment, interagency plan of care, plan for crisis, and transition out of the formal team process.
