A Summary of Qualifications Necessary in Order to Bill Medicaid for Targeted Case Management Services

Qualifications for Developing Assessments and Case Plans

- Case Managers Performing Assessments and Case Plans must have knowledge of:
 - The local service delivery system,
 - The target group's needs,
 - The need for integrated services, and
 - The resources available or needing to be developed.
- Experience / Educational Requirements
 - A degree in a human services-related field *and* one year of supervised experience, or
 - Two years of supervised experience working with people in the target population, or
 - An equivalent combination of training and experience.

Qualifications for Providing Ongoing Monitoring and Service Coordination

Case managers providing ongoing monitoring and service coordination must have knowledge of the following:

- Local service delivery system.
- Target population's needs.
- Need for integrated services.
- Resources available or needing development.

Case managers typically gain such knowledge through one year of supervised experience working with people in the designated target populations.
