How are crisis plans helpful?

- Developing a comprehensive plan before a crisis occurs
- Coordinating resources
- Everyone is on the “same page” -Everyone has the plan so that a response can occur 24/7
- Decrease in worst-case scenario
- Decrease in hospitalization
- Decrease in calls to crisis
- Having the family/child involved helps decrease calls and increases involvement
- With a plan—things are no longer a crisis

Challenges/Issues with developing crisis plan?

- Getting all police departments engaged
- Professional and families are “burned out”
- Resources- finding ways have creative plans and services
- Parents with mental health issues of their own-challenges with follow thru
- Developing trust with families
- Collaboration with schools/law enforcement/county departments/Juvenile Justice
- Transition collaboration
- Trauma informed/not informed
