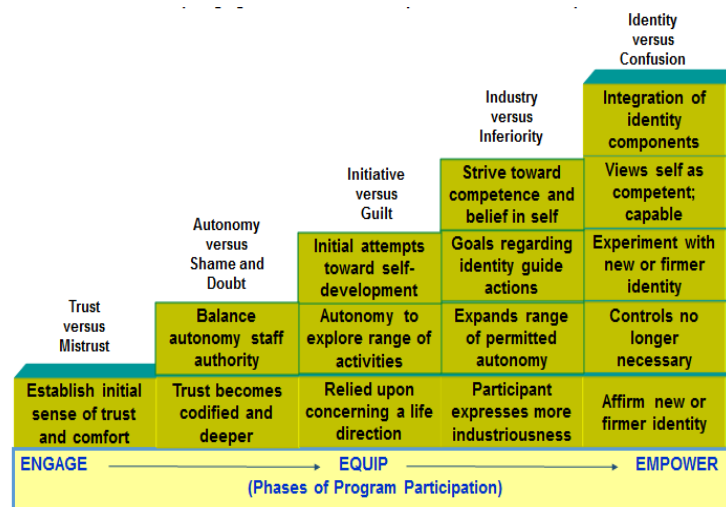
How Did We Get Here?

- ▶ Dissemination is focus

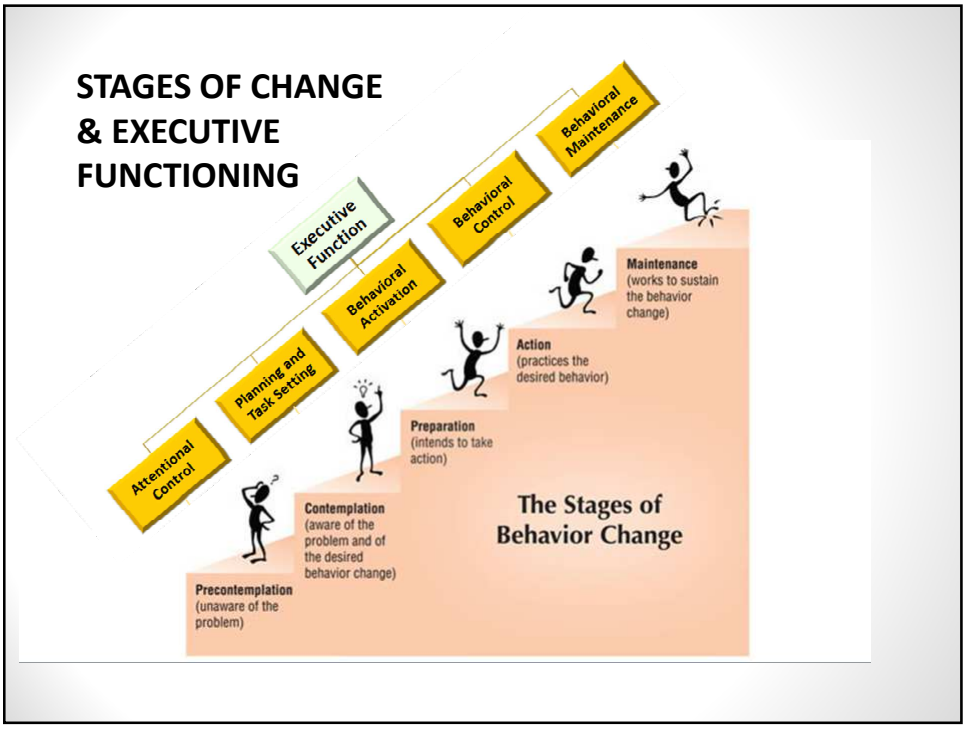
Introduction

- Discuss how we might make similar information available around the state.

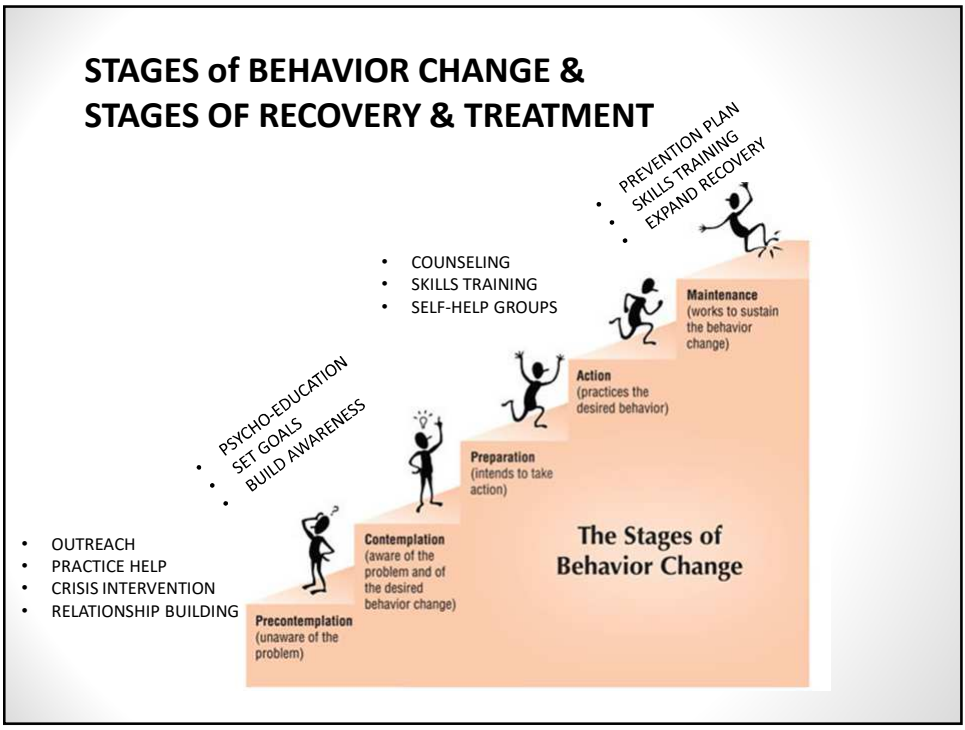
DEVELOPMENTAL STAGES



STAGES OF CHANGE & EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONING



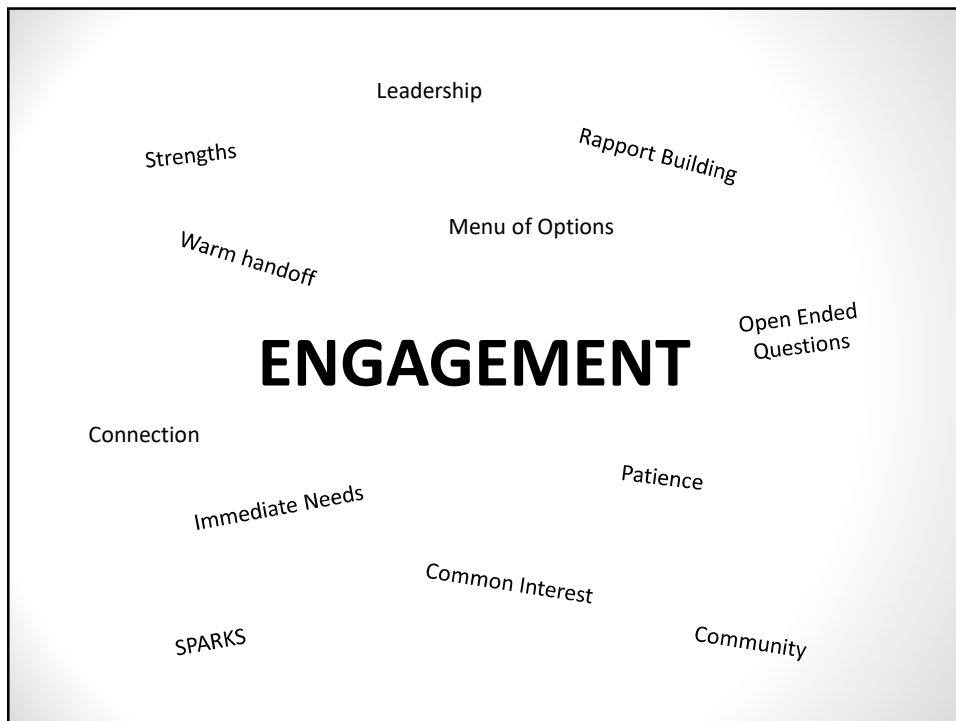
STAGES OF BEHAVIOR CHANGE & STAGES OF RECOVERY & TREATMENT
